ON SHARKS AND HUMANITY

Parkview Museum, a new art space located in Parkview Square, opens its doors with the global art exhibition On Sharks and Humanity. The thematic travelling exhibition addresses the practice of shark finning and the impact of human activity on the oceans through a variety of art forms. Various artists from Singapore, China, Hong Kong, Taiwan, Germany and the United States showcase artworks that explore and analyse the interdependent relationship between sharks, the ocean and human beings, challenging prevailing prejudices surrounding this deeply feared creature and bringing to light the importance of sharks in the marina ecosystem. On Sharks and Humanity is now showing at The Parkview Museum until 26 June. The museum is open to the public with no admission charge.

SIFA 2017 RETURNS

The Singapore International Festival of Arts (SIFA) returns in June for its 2017 edition. For the first time, the festival will span almost four months, starting from 28 June and continuing on till 9 September. With Enchantment as its curatorial theme, SIFA 2017 hopes to encourage the audience to stay connected with world issues. Audience members can expect more engagement with a programme line-up that will draw them in as both audience and participants. Some highlights include My Lai, a performance by American musicians Kronos Quartet based on the 1968 massacre of Vietnamese villagers by American soldiers. Greek tragedy Trojan Women will also be staged as a traditional Korean opera by the National Changeeuk Company of Korea, directed by SIFA Festival Director Ong Keng Sen. or four days between 6 – 9 April, ONE°15 Marina Sentosa Cove was brimming with luxury yachts as some of the most prestigious vessels docked for the seventh edition of the Singapore Yacht Show (SYS). With its largest superyacht to date on display, a record number of Asia debuts and a dazzling social calendar, this year's SYS packed more punch than ever before.

INVIGORATING DISCUSSIONS

The 2017 SYS season was kick-started with the annual Asia Pacific Yachting Conference (APYC), held from 5 – 6 April before the Show's official opening. Representatives from key ASEAN government agencies, captains of industry and members of leading yachting organisations gathered at ONE°15 for discussions on the boating industry. This year's theme was Towards Increased Regional Cooperation to Promote Marine Tourism in the Asia Pacific. Arthur Tay, Chairman of SUTL Group, was amongst the key speakers for the conference. Following the conclusion of the conference, delegates gathered for cocktails at the roof terrace of ONE°15 to enjoy the view of the Singapore Yacht Show.

SENSATIONAL SUPERYACHTS

The stellar line-up at SYS 2017 boasted a fleet of superyachts epitomising the art of luxury living. Australian builder SILVERYACHTS had on show its largest vessel, and also the largest vestel ever to be displayed at the SYS SILVER FAST.

The 77 metre superyacht, with her sleek, aerodyanamic hull form and superstructure certainly cut an imposing figure at the marina. Where SILVER FAST ruled the marina in length, Benetti's majestic superyacht *Ambrosia* triumphed in volume. At 65 metres, the quintuple-deck *Ambrosia* matches the wingspan of a 747 jet.

Also drawing plenty of attention from the crowd was the Norman Foster designed *Ocean Emerald*, the superyacht that starred in the re-make of the movie Point Break. The yacht's unique superstructure, a contemporary masterpiece, stood out from the sea of boats docked at the marina.

DAZZLING DEBUTS

This year, a record number of prominent brands chose the SYS as a platform to debut their newest yachts and concepts. Tri-deck catamaran *Charley*, a 51 metre superyacht support vessel, made her World Premiere at the Show. The vessel was recently delivered to her owner by Australian yard Echo Yachts. Although the yacht is stunning on its own, it is meant to be a shadow vessel and will serve *White Rabbit Golf*, the 84 metre trimaran superyacht currently in production.

Making their Asian debuts were the timelessly elegant *Princess S60* and Jenneau's *Merry Fisher 895*. Asia's leading yacht dealer Simpson Marine had several regional premieres at the Show, including the *Beneteau Oceanis Yacht 62* and the *Beneteau Gran Turismo 46*.

Toys and tenders complete the superyacht experience and with this in mind, the SYS 2017 presented an impressive array of the latest yacht accessories and equipment. From three person submarines to seabobs and inflatables, there was something for everyone.

Taking the experience to the next level, U-Boat Worx let visitors experience the depths of the sea from land through an underwater virtual reality dive experience. Situated on board *Lady Quikglow*, Funair showcased its range of inflatable slides, climbing walls and toys for all ages.

LIFESTYLE ACTIVITIES

There's more to the Singapore Yacht Show then just boats. Over the years, the Show has evolved to become an all-rounded experience with a flurry of activities on land. Supercar parades and fashion shows took place throughout the weekend. For the first time, the Esplanade was transformed into The Lawn, a pop-up hospitality area with food outlets and a 'live' DJ. At the VIP Lounge, Special Guests were welcomed to enjoy the cocktailmaking prowess of Diageo Reserve's WORLD CLASS mixologists.

How did you fall in love with sailing?

My parents had a boat when I was six years old so I have always been around boats all my life. I started sailing in the English Channel and then the Mediterranean. Following that I moved to Asia. The weather here is really hot, so being out on the water is a pleasant environment to spend your time.

What made you decide to purchase Ocean Emerald?

Like most yacht owners, the yachts I owned grew larger and larger over the years. What I particularly liked about *Ocean Emerald* is that it looks very different from other boats. The superstructure is very unique.

Let's talk about the interiors.

When Norman Foster designed the yacht, the interiors were completely white. There was no colour in the boat at all. It was very futuristic and modern, but not necessarily comfortable. When I purchased the yacht, I softened the interiors and made it more homey.

What is your favourite spot on the yacht?

The skylounge. It's a private space for me to retreat to for reading and relaxing. It's more comfortable as compared to the main saloon. That's a bigger and more impersonal space used for entertaining guests.



Ocean Emerald is available for charter. Who are Ocean Emerald's clients?

Mostly families. We have an average of six to eight people for each charter. The yacht has many toys on board like jetskis, kayaks, jet bikes, all sorts that kids really enjoy. It becomes a playground for them. We usually charter the yacht out a few times a year. The rest of the time it's for personal use.

What made you decide to base your yacht in Asia?

Firstly, Asia is my home. Secondly, basing the yacht in the Mediterranean doesn't appeal to me because it's too crowded. In Asia, you have the opportunity to sail out and discover some quiet corners you can have to yourself. For example, Phuket has lots of popular and busy islands but if you sail a hundred miles out you'll find some secluded coves. You won't get that in the Med, there's too many boats.

Any there any memorable trips you've been on with Ocean Emerald?

Every trip is memorable in its own way. Sometimes you get caught in rough weather and that's quite an adventure. Other times you stumble upon some really beautiful places. Burma is always an interesting destination. You can go there for a week and not see any other yachts around. There must be other spots we have yet to uncover. This summer, we are going to cruise around Vietnam for the first time.

There's been a lot of talk on Asia rising as a yachting destination. What are your thoughts on this?

I'm actually quite surprised it didn't get popular sooner! There are many nice places to go here, but not many people are inspired to explore. It seems quite strange to me. But, slowly, I think Asia will rise up. ©

The Club is sitting on land equivalent to the size of 23 football fields.



What is life like at the helm of ONE°15's yacht chartering arm? Longitude caught up with Senior Manager Asrina Riduan Mahmood to find out.

ood morning!" the cheery Asrina calls out to marina staff and yacht captains as she drives the Club buggy down the marina pontoon. "Good morning!" they greet her back, with big smiles and genuine delight at seeing her.

After seven years at the Club, Asrina has built a rapport with everyone at ONE°15. Her infectious, bubbly personality makes her a joy to work with.

Asrina is the Senior Manager of ONE°15's yacht chartering arm – ONE15 Luxury Yachting. It is a role that she actually came to take up by chance.

"I started off in the Sales Catering department of ONE°15," she shares. "I have been selling land venues for many years. But in 2012 the position for department head of ONE15 Luxury Yachting was vacant. And since everyone knows I love the sun and the sea, the role was offered to me," she adds.

As exciting as the position was, it was also daunting. At the beginning, Asrina admits that she lacked in-depth knowledge on the yacht chartering industry. Still, she took on the challenge and dove into it head on.

"My first three months on the job, I literally sat down on the pontoon and talked to boat captains and crew," she shares enthusiastically. "They are the ones who run the show, so they are the best people to go to. I really learned a lot from them, whether it's discovering some of the world's popular sailing destinations, or finding out the various sailing rules and regulations in place in different countries."

Her efforts through the years have paid off. Under her charge, the ONE15 Luxury Yachting fleet has expanded from 14 to 42 yachts. It now stands as the biggest yacht chartering company in Singapore.

But managing such a huge fleet is no easy feat. "Having 42 yachts under us means we have to manage 42 yacht owners, 42 captains and 42 sets of crew. Plus no two yachts are the same and each one requires a different marketing strategy," she divulges.

To better understand the needs of each yacht, Asrina makes it a point to head to the marina to chat with the captain and crew almost daily; just as how she did when she first started. For someone who loves the sun, having the marina as her office is a perk. As she puts it, "I'm not the kind who can stay at her desk the whole day!"



From time to time, Asrina, who has a PPCDL license, also embarks on sailing trips. "I really like the freedom and serenity that comes with being out in the open sea," she says. "Sometimes, it also gives you a sense of excitement. Like when there's a storm!"

Asrina recalls a time when ONE15 Luxury Yachting joined a convoy of over 200 boats on a trip to Bintan. In the middle of the night, when the yachts were anchored at the island, a terrible storm struck. "It was crazy! Some boats were hit by lightning and we were rocking through the night," she reminisces. "It was scary at the time, but now, when I look back, I actually laugh at the memory. It's an experience I will never forget."

Besides Bintan, some of Asrina's favourite island destinations include Tioman and Phuket. She also counts Singapore's Southern Islands as her top spots and hopes that more Singaporeans will explore them. "The yacht chartering industry has really grown. There are more boats available for charter that cater to different budgets and preferences. If you are looking to experience something new in a city like Singapore, the answer is to charter a yacht," she says. "After all, how many times can you go to the zoo or the Singapore Flyer?" she jokes with a laugh.

When you charter a yacht with ONE15 Luxury Yachting, you might just get to meet Asrina herself. From time to time, Asrina accompanies her staff to meet with charter guests upon their arrival at the Club. She even assists to carry their belongings and drives the Club buggy to take them to the boat. "I like to be on the ground with my team to see how things are going and how we can improve," she tells us.

And with the Club clinching the title as Best Asian Marina for the sixth time, it is Asrina's hope that ONE15 Luxury Yachting will ride on its success and grow along with it. "We are currently number one in the Singapore market and I wish to keep that up. Hopefully, other yacht chartering companies can look up to us as an example to follow," she says with a smile. \odot



Aboard Valencia

FOR ONE°15 MEMBER EVANGELINE WONG, A LOVE FOR SAILING EVOLVED INTO A FULL-FLEDGED BUSINESS. WE MEET THE LADY BOSS AND HER FAMILY ON BOARD THEIR PRIZED POSSESSION — VALENCIA.

B uying a 51ft Leopard catamaran hadn't always been the plan. But once Evangeline and her husband Kelvin laid eyes on the boat at the 2013 Singapore Yacht Show, they couldn't help but fall in love with it.

because we are passionate about it," Evangeline describes.
"It also makes us happy when we hear how our customers have enjoyed themselves on board," elaborates Kelvin.

Aside from managing the business, Evangeline also has her hands full looking after the couple's three children – 11-year-old Valencia, seven-year-old Victoria and the latest addition to the family, four-month-old Maximilian.

Evangeline admits that balancing being a businesswoman and a mum, especially one with a new baby, can be challenging at times. "Thankfully, Valencia Yachts has been around for quite some time so it's very stable. We have a lot of repeat customers and word gets around about us quite fast," she shares. "I think that running her own business has also given her a flexible schedule so she can spend time with the kids," adds Kelvin as Evangeline nods in agreement.

"I get to see the kids grow up, which is my favourite part about being a mum. They each have different hobbies and personalities," Evangeline shares. She describes Valencia as the free-spirited drama queen of the family, who is actively involved in her school's drama club. On the other hand, Victoria is a bubbly girl and an avid swimmer. As for little Max: "Well, he loves milk!" Evangeline laughs. "It's too soon to tell what his personality is like, but so far, he is a very easy baby to take care of. He doesn't cry for no reason at all."

For now, when they are not sailing nearby, family bonding activities take place on land. Weekend activities include jogging at Botanic Gardens. 

MAY-JUN 2017 FINE FOOD

here's no denying that coffee has evolved over the years. What was once a beverage consumed to kick-start the day has now become a form of culture, with coffee making considered an art. Coffee drinkers are no longer satisfied with regular coffee and as a response, establishments today are tossing around the term "gourmet coffee" to market their brew. It begs the question, what exactly makes coffee "gourmet"?

"The term "gourmet coffee" basically means good quality coffee," explains Phil Ho, coffee expert and founder of Highlander Coffee Academy. The academy conducts gourmet coffee appreciation workshops for anyone interested in learning a thing or two about the beverage. "There are two kinds of commercially-grown coffee beans in the world – Arabica and Robusta. Generally speaking, the best coffees are all Arabicas."

ARABICA VS ROBUSTA

The two coffee types differ in their taste and growing conditions. Arabica beans are known to be of higher quality – they are grown on high lands and are more flavourful, acidic and aromatic. On the other hand, Robusta beans are grown at lower altitudes and have a bitter and harsher taste. If you're drinking instant coffee, chances are it's all made out of Robusta

Arabicas are disease prone and take several years before yielding the first crop. Compare that to Robustas that are disease resistant and easier to tend to on the farm. Due to a combination of flavour and rarity, Arabica coffee beans are more highly prized.

BEST OF THE BEST

So is gourmet coffee the same as specialty coffee? Yes and no. Specialty coffee is gourmet coffee, but gourmet coffee may not necessarily be specialty coffee. The term "specialty coffee" was first coined in 1974 by Erna Knutsen, founder of Knutsen Coffee. Knutsen used the term to describe beans of the best flavour, produced in special microclimates. So coffee that has earned the title "specialty" are the best of the best in the gourmet coffee world.

There are many standards to fulfill before earning the title, and official certification by coffee associations is needed to qualify. It is not easy to make the cut – only about 10% of the world's gourmet coffee are labeled as specialty. And usually, cups of specialty coffee sell for a lot.

THE WORLD'S FINEST COFFEE

Nonetheless, aficionados can definitely find good coffee that don't necessarily fall into the specialty category. It all boils down to good beans. Traditionally, good beans come from South American countries like Brazil and Colombia and Central American countries like Costa Rica. Africa is right on their heels with Kenyan and Ethiopian coffee ranking amongst the world's finest.

Closer to home, Indonesian coffee has earned itself a stellar reputation. In fact, Indonesia produces one of the world's most expensive coffee – *kopi luwak* – that originates from the coffee beans digested by the Indonesian civet.

There's also much hype surrounding Hawaiian Kona coffee. This deliciously rich and aromatic coffee is grown on the volcanic slopes of Kona, a town in the island of Hawaii. Another celebrated coffee is the Jamaican Blue Mountain that produces a silky smooth and well-balanced cup.

THE GOOD VS THE BAD

There's good coffee and not so good coffee in the market, but how do you suss out a good cuppa? Coffee doesn't necessarily go bad, but if it's consumed weeks after the beans were roasted, the taste starts to stale. That's precisely why Phil says, "In the coffee world, fresh is always best."

The coffee roasting process is also important in determining the taste, and timing is everything. If there's an unusually burnt taste to your coffee, chances are the beans have been over-roasted. When this happens, the aromatic flavours of your coffee beans, no matter how good they are, are ultimately lost.

Then again, it is all up to personal preference. There are those who prefer light roast coffee, while others prefer dark roast coffee. Take for example the Japanese, who are avid consumers of light roast coffee. On the other end of the spectrum are the Italians who love their dark roasts like the quintessential espresso. At the end of the day, the key is to find out what you like. If it's a roast and blend that you enjoy, chances are it's a good cup of coffee.

ART IN A CUP

Rosetta in your coffee? Yes, please. These days, not only is taste important, so is the presentation. Baristas invest time and effort in perfecting their latte art skills. But does it really make a difference? Maybe a little.

Still, your barista's priority should always be focused on brewing a good cup of coffee – one that is well-balanced and suited to your personal taste. The art is simply secondary. As Phil sums it up, "If the coffee is good, the pretty latte art, quite literally, just tops it all off." \bullet
