





NOTICE OF RACE

1. ORGANISING AUTHORITY

The SB20 Asian Grand Slam & Asia Pacific Championship is organised by the Singapore Sailing Federation (SSF) with the support of ONE°15 Marina for and on behalf of the SB20 Association of Singapore.

2. RULES

- 2.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (2025-2028), where applicable, the International Rules for Preventing Collisions at Sea, The Maritime and Port Authority Guideline to Pleasure Craft Licensing.
- 2.2. National authority prescriptions will apply. For RRS 40 Personal Floatation Devices, add on after the rule the following: "Singapore Sailing Federation prescribes that every boat shall carry life-saving equipment conforming to government regulations that apply in the racing area".
- 2.3. In all rules governing this regatta, the notations:
 - 2.3.1. [DP] denotes a rule for which the penalty is applied according to the RRS Introduction –Notation.
 - 2.3.2. [NP] denotes a rule that shall not be grounds for protests by a boat. This changes RRS 60.1.
- 2.4. [DP][NP] In accordance with obtained permission under class rule A6, the class rules are changed as follows:
 - (a) Class rule C.5.1 is deleted entirely and replaced with the following: C5.1 A floating throwing line, minimum of 20m long and 6mm in diameter shall be attached at the stern. This line should also be used at any time during the regatta, when the boat is being towed.
 - (b) Class rule C.4.2: Mobile telephones and handheld GPS may be carried on board.
- 2.5. UMPIRED FLEET RACING will apply.
- 2.6. [DP] The penalty for a breach of the class rules may, at the discretion of the Protest Committee, be less than a disqualification.
- 2.7. [NP] The infringement of RRS Appendix G, IDENTIFICATION ON SAILS, shall not be grounds for protests by a boat. This changes RRS 60.1.
- 2.8. RRS Appendix G3, CHARTERED OR LOANED BOATS, will apply.







- 2.9. If there is a conflict between a rule in the Notice of Race (NoR) and the Sailing Instructions (SI), the rule in the SIs will take precedence. This changes RRS 63.5(c).
- 2.10. If there is a conflict between languages, the English text will take precedence.

3. ADVERTISING

- 3.1. Competitor advertising will be restricted to World Sailing Regulation 20.
- 3.2. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organising Authority.

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1. The regatta is open to SB20s that comply with the Class Rules. Measurement, weighing of the boats and other compliance checks may be carried out during the regatta.
- 4.2. The Organising Authority reserves the right to refuse an entry from any SB20 considered unsuitable for the regatta.
- 4.3. **A minimum of 8 entries** is required for the regatta to proceed.
- 4.4. Eligible teams may enter by registering online at https://one15marina.com/sb20worlds2025/register/ with by the closing date: 8th January 2025, no later than 1700hrs. NOTE details on fees and Early Bird discounts in Fees.
- 4.5. All Singapore registered boats must be fully paid-up members of the SB20 Association of Singapore. All foreign registered boats must be fully paid-up members of their foreign equivalent to the SB20 Association of Singapore.

5. FEES

5.1. The entry fee is \$900.00 per boat (9% GST included). **The fees are non-refundable unless the regatta is cancelled.** Boats that register by the early bird deadline of 10th December, 2024 will enjoy a \$100 discount on their entry fee for a total of \$800.00.







6. THE COURSE

6.1. The race course will be windward-leeward off the East Coast as defined in the Sailing Instructions.

7. SCHEDULE

7.1. The schedule of activities will be as follows:

- 7.2. There are 12 races scheduled for the regatta
- 7.3. 3 Practice Races are scheduled for the Practice Race and 4 Races are scheduled for each race day.
- 7.4. No warning signals will be made after 1600h on 12th January 2025

8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

8.1. The sailing instructions will be available by 2nd January 2025.

9. MEASUREMENTS

- 9.1. All boats and equipment shall be available for random measurement checks by the Organising Authority.
- 9.2. Crew weighing will be carried out as per the schedule in point 7 above.
- 9.3. Sail checks may be carried out during registration.







10. SCORING

- 10.1. A minimum of 4 races are required to constitute the SB20 Asian Grand Slam & Asia Pacific Championship.
- 10.2. When fewer than 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 10.3. When at least 6 but less than 10 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 10.4. When 10 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her 2 worst scores.

11. HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

11.1. Boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with, and according to the terms of prior written permission of the Organising Authority.

12. RADIO COMMUNICATION

- 12.1. Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not receive voice or data communications that are not available to all boats.
- 12.2. Race Officer and ONE°15 Marina will transmit and receive on VHF76.

13. VENUE

- 13.1. The SB20 Asian Grand Slam and Asia Pacific Championship is hosted by ONE°15 Marina Sentosa Cove.
- 13.2. Racing area will be on the waters off the East Coast and will be defined in the Sailing Instructions.

14. PRIZES

14.1. Prizes will be awarded for the overall top 3 finishers and the top Student Team, with other prizes at the discretion of the OA.







15. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

15.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk, see RRS 3, Decision to Race. The Organising Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

16. INSURANCE

16.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.

17. CHARTER BOATS

17.1. Singapore Sailing Federation and various private owners have boats available for charter. The SB20 Association of Singapore can assist interested sailors to charter boats for the regatta. Charter fees start at SGD 1,000 for the event.
